- MUST include artist's name, age, and school on back of artwork. If homeschooled, provide phone number instead of school.
- Be appropriate for public display (judges reserve the right to exclude artwork deemed inappropriate.)

## The winners' artwork will be on display during the Down Home Days Festival on April 22nd.

Other artwork may be on display based on the number of entries.
